Audit 2019

IPARKS Insurance

Sauerwein reported that he received the IPARKS renewal over the weekend. The Committee received an electronic version as well as hard copies. The new premium is \$25,800, last year it was \$24,435.

Sauerwein reported that he has met with an electrician to provide a quote to install the pickleball lights.
